

## INDIRECT

The INDIRECT OBJECT  
is always a person (or animal).

The INDIRECT OBJECT  
receives the action  
of the verb *indirectly*.

\_\_\_\_\_ *to whom?*  
\_\_\_\_\_ *for whom?*

me      nos  
te      os  
le      les

## DIRECT

The DIRECT OBJECT  
could be any noun  
(person, place, thing).

The DIRECT OBJECT  
receives the action  
of the verb *directly*.

\_\_\_\_\_ *what?*  
\_\_\_\_\_ *who?*

me      nos  
te      os  
lo, la      los, las

## Don't forget the "se"

Se is an indirect object pronoun that replaces "le" or "les" in double-pronoun sentences.

Yo te las compré.

se  
Yo ~~le~~ las compré.

Ella me lo vendió.

se  
Ella ~~les~~ lo vendió.

Tú nos la prestaste.

se  
Tú ~~le~~ la prestaste.
