

Indirect Object Pronouns

*You've been using them since level 1.

- They are used with the verb "gustar".

-An indirect object pronoun expresses
to / for whom an action is performed

-You can specify or over emphasize by using personal a.

A mí, A tí, A nosotros,

A ella, A él, A ud., A ellos, A ellas, A uds. **Have to specify**

Indirect Object Pronouns

Me	Nos
Te	Os
Le*	Les*

When using indirect object pronouns you can see
an overlap in the sentence.

Elena **me** dice **a mí** que *Shakira* es su amiga.

Tú **le** dices **a Ana** *un secreto*.

Nosotros **te** decimos **a tí** que *Justin Beiber* no es muy guapo.

Te toca a tí (Your turn) ¿Cuáles debe ser azules (I.O.) y negros ?

Yo **te** digo **a tí** que mi clase es fácil.

Ella nos dice **a nosotros** que somos muy inteligentes.

Tú **les** dices **a ellos** que tienen tarea.

Juan **me** dice **a mí** un secreto.
